3. If carrier is a corporation or limited liability company or limited partnership, I/we certify that the carrier is an active corporation, limited liability company, or limited partnership in good standing with the office of the California Secretary of State.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT REINSTATEMENT FROM REVOCATION

When you submit this Form TL 702 and pay the \$125 reinstatement fee, your authority will not necessarily be reinstated immediately. Before the License Section reinstates your authority, it must confirm all of the following:

1. That you have all required insurance on file with the License Section, and that no required insurance is due to be cancelled within 30 days. It is advisable to check with your insurer(s) when, or before, you submit this form;
2. That you have paid all TRF fees and penalties owed, not just the quarter for which you may have been suspended and revoked;
3. That you have no outstanding balance due to the Commission;
4. That if the authority was issued to a corporation or limited liability company or limited partnership, it is an active corporation, limited liability company, or limited partnership in good standing with the office of the California Secretary of State;
5. That you have paid, or are paying timely, any fines imposed by the Enforcement Section, and that it has no objection to the reinstatement of your authority(ies).

Only if the License Section finds no deficiencies in any of the above areas will it reinstate your authority. Normally, this will require no more than 5 business days to confirm. However, if the License Section does find any deficiencies, it will notify you in writing, including what you must do to correct the deficiency(ies). This notice will include a deadline, approximately 60 days, by which time you must correct all deficiencies in order to be reinstated. If you fail to correct all deficiencies by that deadline, you must reapply and pay the \$500 application fee.
