RE: Time Extension Request of G.10-06-017

Dear Ms. Namazi:

This refers to your letter dated July 9, 2012, requesting a time extension to December 31, 2013, to comply with the provisions of the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) General Order (GO) 88-B approval letter issued on July 21, 2010. This approval letter authorized the alteration of the at-grade crossing at Fifth Street, CPUC # 108AE-75.90 and Dot No. 751231 across the tracks of the California Northern Railroad (CNRR) in the City of Davis (City) in Yolo County.

In a letter dated June 14, 2012, CNRR states that they concur with the City's time extension request to December 31, 2013.

The Commission's Rail Crossings Engineering Section (RCES) investigation of this extension request finds that there has been no substantial change in circumstances since the granting of the original authority. RCES has no objections to the requested time extension.

In consideration of the above, the City is granted a time extension to December 31, 2013, to complete the alterations of the crossing. In all other respects, the approval letter issued on July 21, 2010, shall remain in full force and effect.

**Although not included in the original authorization letter, the City should inform CNRR of the completion of its work (In addition to submitting the required Form G to the CPUC). At the conclusion of the project, CNRR should submit an updated Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) inventory form to the FRA, reflecting the changes. Commission requests a concurrent copy of the updated inventory form be submitted to [rces@cpuc.ca.gov](mailto:rces@cpuc.ca.gov).**
