Dear Mr. Woo:

This refers to your letter dated March 21, 2013, received by us on April 4, 2013, requesting authorization, pursuant to California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) General Order (GO) 88-B, to alter the Mission Bay Drive at-grade highway rail-crossing of the Peninsula Corridor Joint Power Board (Caltrain) track in City of San Francisco (City), County of San Francisco. The crossing is identified as CPUC Crossing No. 105E-0.80 and DOT No. 922712X.

Rail Crossing Engineering Section (RCES) has investigated the request by the City to alter the crossing and finds the GO 88-B application is missing the letter of concurrence from Caltrain. The concurrence of the rail organization is a vital part of the GO 88-B application process. Accordingly, your GO-88-B request for authority to alter the referenced crossing is hereby rejected without prejudice.

RCES recommends that the City submit a revised GO 88-B request incorporating the letter of concurrence from Caltrain.
