Time Extension Request for XREQ 2010090018 to Modify Five Interstate 605 Freeway Grade-Separated Highway-Rail Crossings in City of Irwindale, Los Angeles County.

Dear Mr. Burner:

This refers to your letter, dated September 11 2013, requesting a time extension to comply with the provisions of General Order 88-B approval letter issued on November 12, 2010. The approval letter authorized modification of five grade-separated highway-rail crossings (crossings) of the Interstate 605 (I-605) Freeway and Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (LACMTA) Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension tracks in City of Irwindale (City), County of Los Angeles. The crossings are identified in the table below:

The original authorization expired on November 12, 2012. The modification construction has been delayed due to funding. Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension Construction Authority (Foothill Authority) is requesting additional time to complete the construction. The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), LACMTA, and City provided concurrence to the time extension request.

The California Public Utilities Commission's (Commission) Rail Crossings Engineering Section (RCES) investigated the request by Foothill Authority and finds that there has been no

substantial change in circumstances since granting the original authority. Since the City, Caltrans, and LACMTA concur with the requested time extension, you may proceed with the alterations as previously authorized by the Commission on November 12, 2010. This authorization shall expire on November 12, 2015.

Within 30 days after completion of this project, Foothill Authority shall notify RCES that the authorized work is completed, by submitting a Commission Standard Form G titled Report of Changes at Highway Grade Crossings and Separation. Form G requirements and forms can be obtained at the Commission web site Form G page http://www.cpuc.ca.gov/PUC/safety/Rail/Crossings/formg. This report may be submitted electronically to rces@cpuc.ca.gov as outlined on the web page.

In all other respects the original authorization for improvements remains in full force and effect. Should the work not be completed by November 12, 2015, RCES may require a new GO 88-B application for the crossing modifications.
