Re: Time Extension Request for XREQ 2011030015 to Modify the Jackson Street At-Grade Highway-Rail Crossing, Identified as CPUC Crossing No. 002B-15.80 and DOT No. 026507V, in the City of Riverside, Riverside County.

Dear Mr. Mohammadi:

This refers to your letter dated April 2, 2014, received on April 8, 2014, requesting a time extension to modify the Jackson Street at-grade highway-rail crossing (crossing) of the BNSF Railway Company's (BNSF) Mainline 2B railroad tracks, in the City of Riverside (City), Riverside County. The crossing is identified as CPUC No. 002B-15.80 and DOT No. 026507V.

The original authorization was granted on April 27, 2011, and will expire on April 27, 2014. The project has encountered delays in acquiring and installation of new warning devices. City is requesting additional time to complete the proposed crossing modifications. BNSF provided concurrence to the time extension request.


The California Public Utilities Commission's (Commission) Rail Crossings Engineering Section (RCES) investigated the request by the City and finds that there has been no substantial change in circumstances since granting original authority. Since City and BNSF are in agreement and have no objection to the requested time extension, you may proceed with the alterations as previously authorized by the Commission on April 27, 2011, with a three year time extension. This authorization shall expire on April 27, 2017.

Within 30 days after completion of this project, City shall notify RCES that the authorized work is completed, by submitting a completed Commission Standard Form G titled *Report of Changes at Highway Grade Crossings and Separation*.
