This refers to your letters, dated March 26, 2014, and March 27, 2014, requesting an extension of time to comply with the provisions of General Order 88-B approvals issued in 2011 for authorization to alter various grade-separated and at-grade highway-rail crossings, identified in the table below, as part of the Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension Phase 2A Project through the Cities of Arcadia, Irwindale, Monrovia, Duarte, Azusa, and Glendora (Cities), County of Los Angeles.

The Cities, County of Los Angeles Department of Public Works, Southern California Regional Rail Authority, California Department of Transportation, BNSF Railway Company, and Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transit Authority provided concurrence by email for the time extension request.


The California Public Utilities Commission's (Commission) Rail Crossings Engineering Section (RCES) investigated the request by the Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension Construction Authority (Foothill Authority) and finds there has been no substantial change in circumstances since the granting of the original authority.

In consideration of the above, Foothill Authority is granted an extension of time to September 23, 2015 to complete the alterations of the crossings. In all other respects, the original authorizations for improvements remain in full force and effect.

Within 30 days after completion of this project, Foothill Authority shall notify RCES that the authorized work is completed, by submitting a completed Commission Standard Form G title Report of Changes at Highway Grade Crossings and Separation.
