**RE: Time Extension Request for XREQ2015030006, Interstate 5 Southbound Grade-Separated Crossing, CPUC Crossing No. 001C-274.07-A and DOT No. 441001Y, near the Town of Lakehead in unincorporated County of Shasta.**

Dear Ms. Melvin:

This refers to your letter, received on May 21, 2018, requesting an extension of time to comply with the provisions of the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) General Order (GO) 88-B approval letter XREQ2015030006, issued on April 8, 2015. The original XREQ2015030006 letter authorized the alteration of the grade-separated highway-rail crossing of the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) Valley Subdivision track at Southbound Interstate 5 near the Town of Lakehead in unincorporated Shasta County. The crossing is identified as CPUC Crossing No. 001C-274.07-A and DOT No. 441001Y.

California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has requested an extension through December 31, 2019. UPRR representatives provided concurrence to the time extension request.

The Commission's Rail Crossings and Engineering Branch (RCEB) investigated the extension request by Caltrans and finds that there have been no changes in circumstances since granting of the original authority.


In consideration of the above, Caltrans is granted a time extension to December 31, 2019, to complete the alterations of the crossing. In all other respects, the approval letter issued on April 8, 2015, shall remain in full force and effect.

Should the work not be completed by December 31, 2019, RCEB may require a new GO 88-B application for the crossing modifications.
