Time Extension Request for General Order 88-B Authorization XREQ2016080007 to Alter the Birkmont Drive At-Grade Highway-Rail Crossing, CPUC Crossing No. No. 083E-18.52 and DOT No. 926341D, in Sacramento County

Dear Mr. Shoeman:

This refers to your letter, received by us on August 30, 2019, requesting an extension of time to comply with the provisions of the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) General Order (GO) 88-B approval letter XREQ2016080007 issued on September 1, 2016. XREQ2016080007 authorized the alteration of the existing Birkmont Drive at-grade highway-rail crossing (crossing) of Sacramento Regional Transit District (SRTD) track in Sacramento County (County).

The GO 88-B authorization expires on September 1, 2019. The County is requesting an extension of 36 months to complete the improvements. SRTD and the City of Folsom have concurred with the requested time extension.


The Commission's Rail Crossings and Engineering Branch (RCEB) investigated the time extension request and finds that there has been no substantial change in circumstances since the granting of the original authority. RCEB has no objections to the requested extension.

In consideration of the above, the County is granted an extension of time to September 1, 2022, to complete the alterations of the crossing. In all other respects, the approval letter issued on September 1, 2016, shall remain in full force and effect.
