Re: Time Extension Request for General Order 88-B Authorization XREQ2017100003 to Alter the First Street At-Grade Highway-Rail Crossing, CPUC Crossing No. 001C-116.60, and DOT Crossing No. 753236W, in the City of Lincoln, County of Placer.

Dear Ms. Cazarez:

This refers to your letter dated October 5, 2020, received by us on October 12, 2020, requesting an extension of time to comply with the provisions of the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) General Order (GO) 88-B approval letter XREQ2017100003 issued on November 21, 2017. XREQ2017100003 authorized the City of Lincoln (City) to alter the First Street at-grade highway-rail crossing (crossing) of the Union Pacific Railroad Company (UPRR) track in the City, County of Placer. The crossing is identified as CPUC Crossing No. 001C-116.60 and DOT Crossing No. 753236W.

The GO 88-B authorization will expire on November 21, 2020. The City is requesting an extension of 36 months to complete the alteration of the crossing. UPRR has concurred with the requested time extension.

The Commission's Rail Crossings and Engineering Branch (RCEB) has investigated the time extension request and finds that there has been no substantial change in circumstances since the granting of the original authority. RCEB has no objections to the requested extension.

In consideration of the above, the City is granted an extension of time to November 21, 2023, to complete the alterations of the crossing. In all other respects, the approval letter issued on November 21, 2017 shall remain in full force and effect.
