**Re: Time Extension Request for General Order 88-B Authorization XREQ2018060005 to Alter the Evans Avenue At-Grade Highway-Rail Crossing, CPUC Crossing No. 002SF-2.35, and DOT Crossing No. 016590W, in the City and County of San Francisco.**

Dear Mr. Desai:

This refers to your letter dated and received by us on May 19, 2021, requesting an extension of time to comply with the provisions of the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) General Order (GO) 88-B approval letter XREQ2018060005 issued on July 2, 2018. XREQ2018060005 authorized the City of San Francisco (City) to temporarily alter the Evans Avenue at-grade highway-rail crossing (crossing) of the Union Pacific Railroad Company (UPRR) track in the City and County of San Francisco. The crossing is identified as CPUC Crossing No. 002F-2.35 and DOT Crossing No. 016590W.

The GO 88-B authorization will expire on July 1, 2021. The City is requesting an extension until February of 2024. UPRR has concurred with the requested time extension.

The Commission's Rail Crossings and Engineering Branch (RCEB) investigated the time extension request and finds that there has been no substantial change in circumstances since the granting of the original authority. RCEB has no objections to the requested extension.

In consideration of the above, the City is granted an extension of time to July 1, 2024, to complete the alterations of the crossing. In all other respects, the approval letter issued on July 2, 2018, shall remain in full force and effect.
