**Re: Second Time Extension Request for XREQ 2018060006 to Alter the Ferrari Ranch Road Rail Crossing**

Dear Araceli Cazarez:

This refers to your letter dated May 20, 2024, received by us on July 2, 2024, requesting a second time extension to complete the alteration of the Ferrari Ranch Road rail crossing (crossing) of the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) track, in the City of Lincoln (City), County of Placer. The crossing is identified as CPUC Crossing Number 001C-116.10 and DOT Number 753235P.

The California Public Utilities Commission (Commission/CPUC) Rail Crossings and Engineering Branch (RCEB) granted the original authorization on July 31, 2018 for three years with the expiration date of July 31, 2021. A three-year time extension was granted in 2021. The City states the construction will be scheduled and started by the end of the 2024 calendar year and requests additional time to complete construction. UPRR provided evidence of agreement to the time extension request. City of Lincoln confirms that there has been no change in scope from the original General Order (GO) 88-B request.

RCEB reviewed the request by the City of Lincoln and finds that there has been no substantial change in circumstances since granting the original authorization. RCEB approves this second-time extension request and City of Lincoln may continue the alterations as previously authorized by the Commission with a three-year time extension.

The following requirements pertain to this time extension:

- The crossing shall have the configuration and operational characteristics as described and specified in the original request letter and its attachments.
- Within 30 days after the authorized scope of alterations is complete, the City shall notify RCEB of the alterations by submitting a Form G to [rceb@cpuc.ca.gov](mailto:rceb@cpuc.ca.gov). Form G requirements and forms are available on the CPUC web site at <http://www.cpuc.ca.gov/crossings>.
- UPRR shall electronically submit an updated Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) inventory form (Form F6180.71) to the FRA per 49 C.F.R. § 234.411(c).

In all other respects, the original authorization XREQ 2018060006 remains in full force and effect. Should the work not be complete by July 31, 2027, RCEB will require a new General Order 88-B request.
