

Question 3108: I would like to request data related to PG&E’s gas leaks, per the following table, for the period January 1, 2012 to June 30, 2012. I would like to request that this data be provided by 2:00 PM on July 25, 2012, or sooner.

Response 3108: The leak information requested has been entered the in the table below. This information was developed from the data in PG&E’s IGIS (integrated gas information system) database as of July 25, 2012. Please understand that the IGIS database is dynamic and is updated on a daily basis. For example during the first six months of 2012 some leaks would have been re-graded or eliminated, so it is not possible to have the columns in the table reconcile. Also, the data can change after today as a result of QC, delayed data entry or other work, where we find or correct an error and that any work done now may change historical numbers making it difficult to compare today’s report with future reports. The information supplied is based on a data query with the following assumptions:

- “Found by the end of June 2012” means leaks found from January 1, 2012 through June 30, 2012.
- “Repaired by the end of June 2012” means leaks repaired from January 1, 2012 through June 30, 2012.
- “Existing by the end of June 2012” means active leaks in the IGIS system on June 30, 2012.
