## **QUESTION 959**

The NBC Bay Area investigative unit article titled Gas Leaks & Repair Delays at PG&E dated August 13, 2012, states "A document containing data from the California Public Utility Commission obtained by NBC Bay Area shows that PG&E had 988 leaks not repaired in the time required by state regulators." Please: (1) describe and explain PG&E's understanding of the identity and purpose of the document referred to in the article; (2) describe the scope of the 988 leaks repaired statistic in terms of time period and operations covered; (3) indicate if PG&E has the document and provide the document; and (4) identify and explain the underlying sources of the leaks repaired late statistics shown on the document. Indicate if the statistics were taken from PG&E's IGIS system and Gas Statistical Reports.

## ANSWER 959

The document referred to in the NBC Bay Area News article was originally provided to the CPUC as part of the "San Bruno GT Line Rupture Investigation" as CPUC\_203-Q04. It is attached for your reference as GasDistributionExpendituresAudit DR OverlandConsulting 027-Q959Atch01.

The CPUC forwarded this document to House Representative, Jackie Speier, who in turn provided the document to NBC Bay Area News. Based on inquiries from NBC Bay Area News, PG&E prepared responses to a number of questions that explained and clarified the information in the document originally provided to the CPUC.
