All. POLE ATTACHMENTS

A. DESCRIPTION

Attachments to the poles of the Utility are available for farmer line service and to Connecting Companies where facilities are available.

B. TERRITORY

Within territory where poles of the Utility are located.

C. REGULATIONS

- 1. For purposes of this schedule, a Connecting Company is a telephone company not directly or indirectly controlling, or controlled by, or under direct or indirect common control with, the Utility furnishing telephone service, whose facilities are interconnected with those of the Utility.
- 2. Attachment charges will be billed from the date attachments are made to the end of the year and annually in advance thereafter.
- 3. Where attachments of telephone wires involve placing of brackets, the brackets and insulators shall be furnished and placed at expense of the farmer line subscribers or connecting company involved.
- 4. Where attachments of telephone wires involve use of crossarms, the insulators shall be furnished and placed at expense of the farmer line subscribers or connecting company involved.
