1.1 GENERAL INFORMATION

This schedule contains a general statement relative to the Category III Services rendered, and the availability of tariff sheets.

All references to Pacific Bell Telephone Company, Pacific Bell and/or Pacific Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company are to be considered interchangeable for purposes of these tariff schedules. Pacific Bell Telephone Company is doing business as SBC Pacific Bell Telephone Company and SBC California ("Pacific Bell Telephone Company d/b/a SBC Pacific Bell Telephone Company and d/b/a SBC California").

1.1.1 APPLICABILITY

Applicable to Category III Services furnished by Pacific Bell, those services described in Schedule Cal.P.U.C. No. D3. are provided by Pacific Bell Information Services, a separate but wholly owned subsidiary of Pacific Bell, hereinafter referred to as the Utility, over facilities wholly within the State of California. While the tariff sheets act as a contract for a Category III Service, Customer and/or Utility may nonetheless desire to execute a written agreement for the provision of a Category III Service. This tariff does not prohibit Customer and Utility from executing such agreements; as long as such agreements do not have terms and conditions inconsistent with this tariff.

1.1.2 FILING OF REGULATIONS

These schedules have been regularly filed with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California, and are the effective regulations of the Utility for the provision of Category III Services.

No officer, employee or agent of the Utility has any authority to arbitrarily waive, alter or amend in any respect these regulations, or any part thereof, or to make any agreements inconsistent therewith.
