DBA Name	Doing Business As (DBA) Name of your company. In other words, the name of the entity customers could contact to purchase service.	Text	AAA Company

Tract Code	11-digit 2010 Census Tract code. ALL California Census codes begin with “06”. See <a href="#">More about Census Tracts</a> .	Text	06001006202

Minimum Downstream Bandwidth ( <i>MinDown</i> )	The minimum advertised downstream bandwidth, or the downstream speed users should expect to receive in the coverage area, in Mbps. (You can enter up to 3 places after the decimal (i.e. 768 = 0.768))	Float	3
Minimum Upstream Bandwidth ( <i>MinUp</i> )	The minimum advertised downstream bandwidth, or the downstream speed users should expect to receive in the coverage area, in Mbps. (You can enter up to 3 places after the decimal (i.e. 768 = 0.768))	Float	0.768
In-service subscriber connections ( <i>Subscribers</i> )	In-service connections, where the device and subscription permit the user to access the lawful Internet content of the user’s choice at information transfer rates exceeding 200 kbps in at least one direction.	Integer	100
Consumer Subscribers ( <i>ConsumSubscr</i> )	Of the total number of subscribers, the number that are not billed to a corporate, non-corporate business, government or institutional customer account. Please note that you should enter the number of subscribers rather than a percentage of the total.	Integer	57
