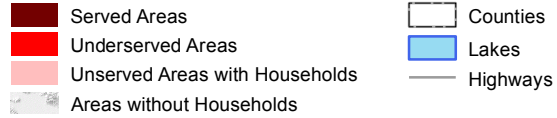




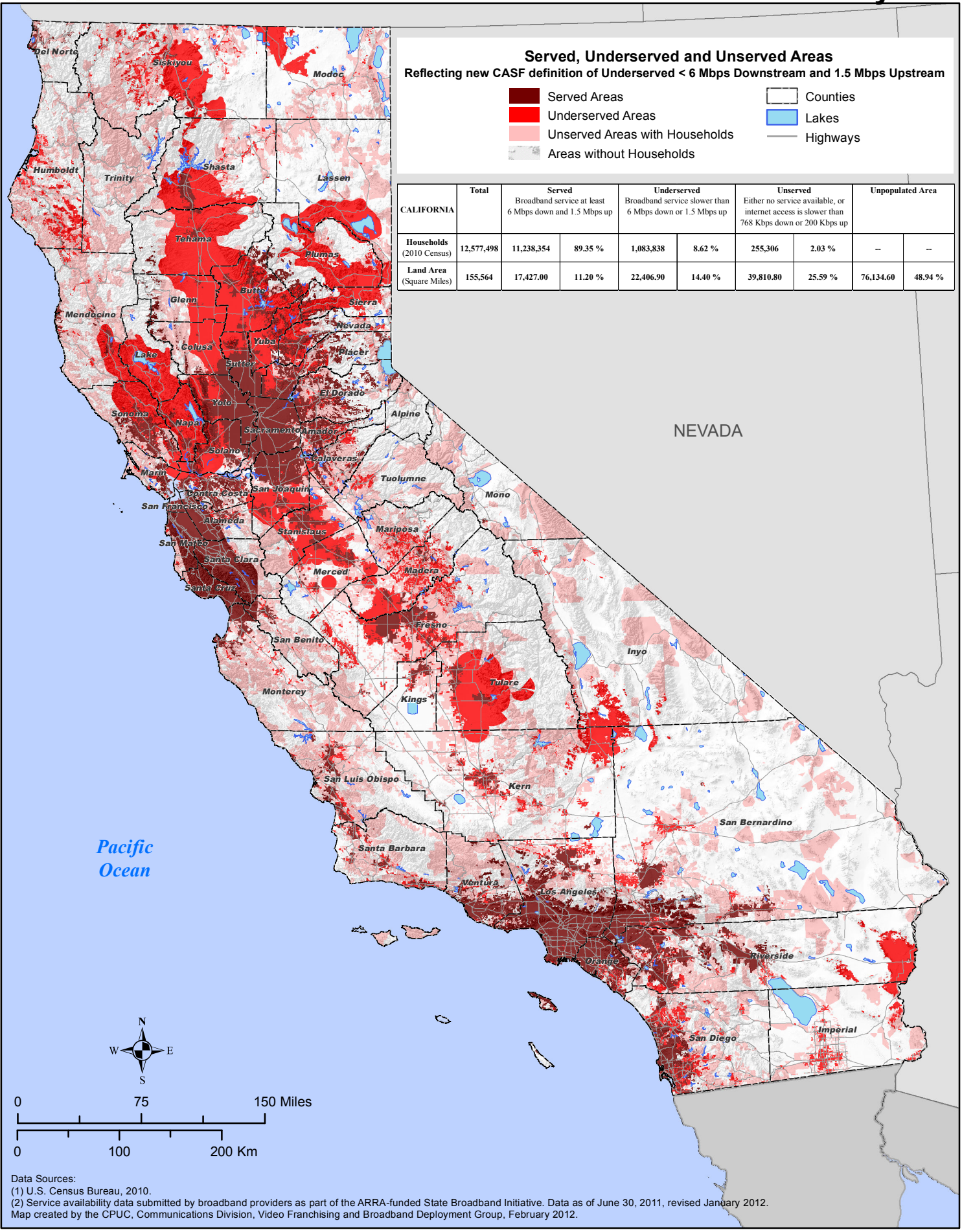

Wireline and Fixed Wireless Broadband Availability

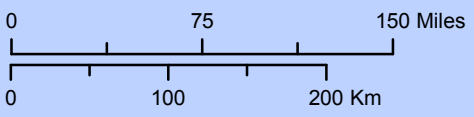
