NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR SUPPLEMENTAL CASF FUNDING

The Commission has received a request for \$11.38 million in additional funding from the CASF Infrastructure Account to complete the Klamath River Rural Broadband Initiative (KRRBI), originally approved in [Resolution T-17418](#).

A summary of the request and a map of the proposed new project area are posted on the CASF Infrastructure Grant proposed projects section of the Commission's website at: [CASF Applications - Project Summaries](#).

In addition to requesting additional funding, the grantee proposes to expand on the approved project area, triggering a challenge requirement. Per [Resolution T-17443](#), challengers have fourteen calendar days from the date that projects are posted online. The deadline for submitting challenges for these proposed projects is Wednesday, May 24, 2019. Please note that the only areas eligible for challenge are new areas identified in this proposal. The previously approved project area is not subject to challenge.

Any party that challenges a proposed area or CB as already served must provide supporting documentation (e.g., maps of their service area(s), copy of a customer bill, and addresses of households in their service area(s)) to enable staff to verify the challengers' allegation that the area(s) are already served. The Communications Division (CD) will then investigate and inform the applicant if there are any challenges. Once CD makes a final determination, it will notify the applicant of its determination.
